With the need to provide for the learning success of all children, the Response to Intervention (RtI) initiative in the State of Illinois requires all school leaders to implement 3-Tiered academic and behavioral supports for students in their buildings. Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) applies to a data based, problem-solving process to enhance the capacity of schools to effectively educate all students. Leadership examples for integration of PBIS into School Improvement initiatives (working smarter, not harder) including Standards Aligned Curriculum, Response to Intervention (RtI), and Systems of Support, will be addressed in this interactive session.
