Why Power Standards?

The most important attributes of curriculum and assessments are that they are guaranteed, viable and aligned with state standards. This workshop focuses on the process that two school districts (K-12) went through in creating a curriculum through a development and alignment process, implementing lessons and common assessments, utilizing a data warehouse system to evaluate student achievement through progress monitoring, and

adjusting classroom instruction. These two school districts created Power Standards through identifying what students need to know and understand, creating instructional objectives, sequenced for student learning and preparing common assessments to measure student learning. Examples of software that effectively allows clear data analysis of appropriate assessment will be related to the data.
